Tenor Malbec is true both to the brand and the grape. Like all Tenor wines, it is richly textured, fruit forward, and unabashedly opulent. But true to the varietal, it is fresh, beautifully perfumed and supremely silky. If you love malbec, you'll love the way Tenor malbec accentuates the notes that define this varietal, and even if you don't drink a lot of malbec, we think you'll be surprised and delighted to see that such a beautifully aromatic wine can still have so much palate presence, texture and intensity. Some of the same growing conditions that make Argentine malbec so prized also contribute to the varietal's tremendous success in Washington. We have dramatic swings between warm day and cool nights, as well as the higher altitudes that promote concentration and texture. The intense perfume and color make it a great complement to other grapes, but when producing a 100% single varietal, it's essential to balance that with the more concentrated fruit

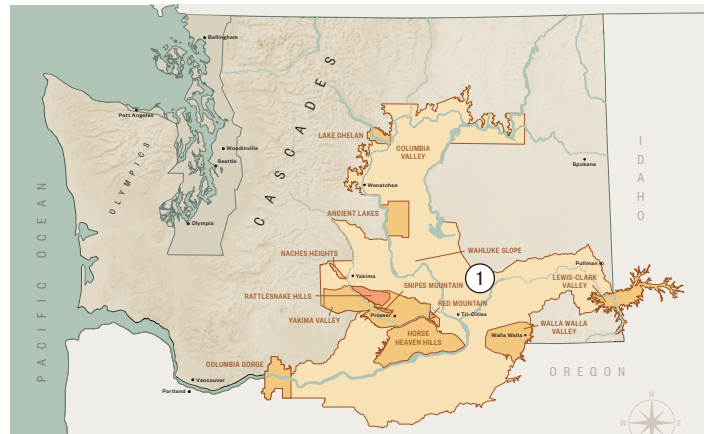
and textured mouthfeel. A plush mouthfeel and incredible freshness make it a great early drinking wine, but it also ages exceptionally well, keeping it's youthful form through 8, 10, even 12 years.

An opulent mixture of blackberry, plum concentrate, kola nut, spring flowers and new leather. Swirling adds sweetness to the fruit and an earthy forest floor note mixed with black olive. The palate has freshness, a creamy texture and perfect tannins. A riper wine than previous vintages but with terrific balance. This will be stunning to drink in its youth.
